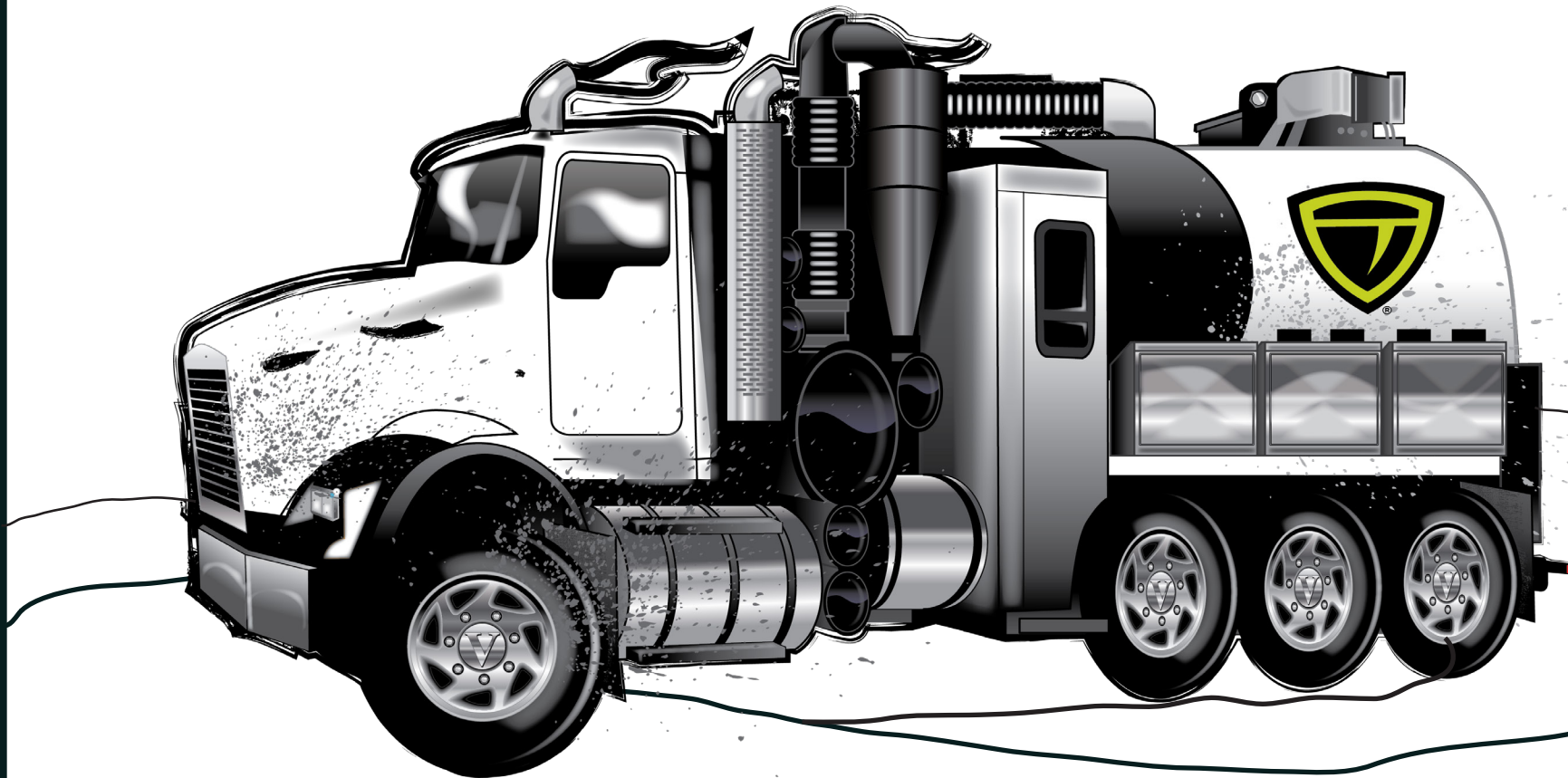

What is 811?

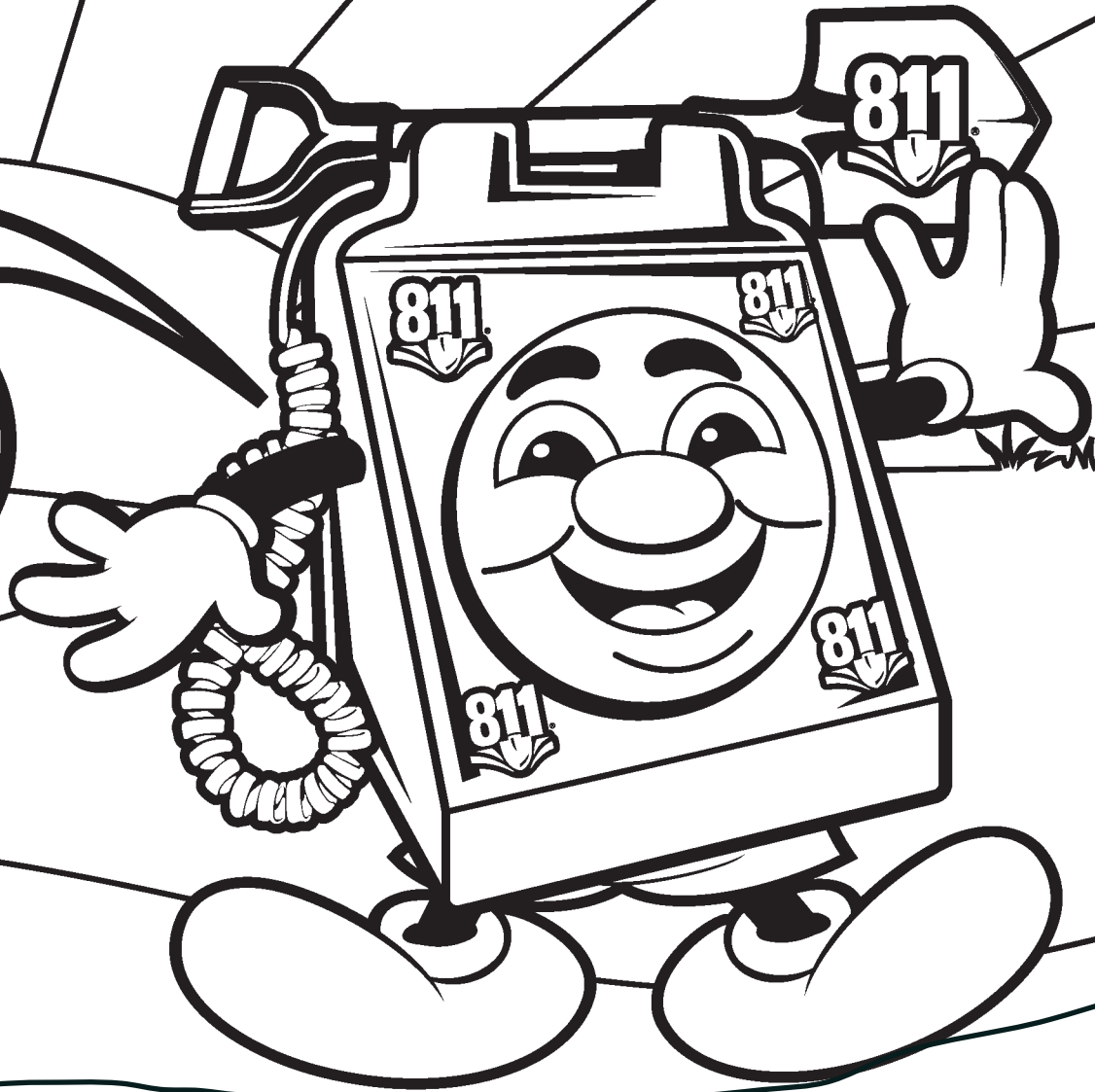
811 is the national call-before-you-dig phone number. Anyone who plans to dig should call 811 or go to their state 811 center's website a few business days before digging to request that the approximate location of buried utilities be marked with paint or flags so that you don't unintentionally dig into an underground utility line.

811 protects you and your community! Hitting a buried line while digging can disrupt utility service, cost money to repair, or cause serious injury or death. Always contact your 811 center, wait the required time for utilities to respond to your request, and ensure that all utilities have responded to your request before putting a shovel in

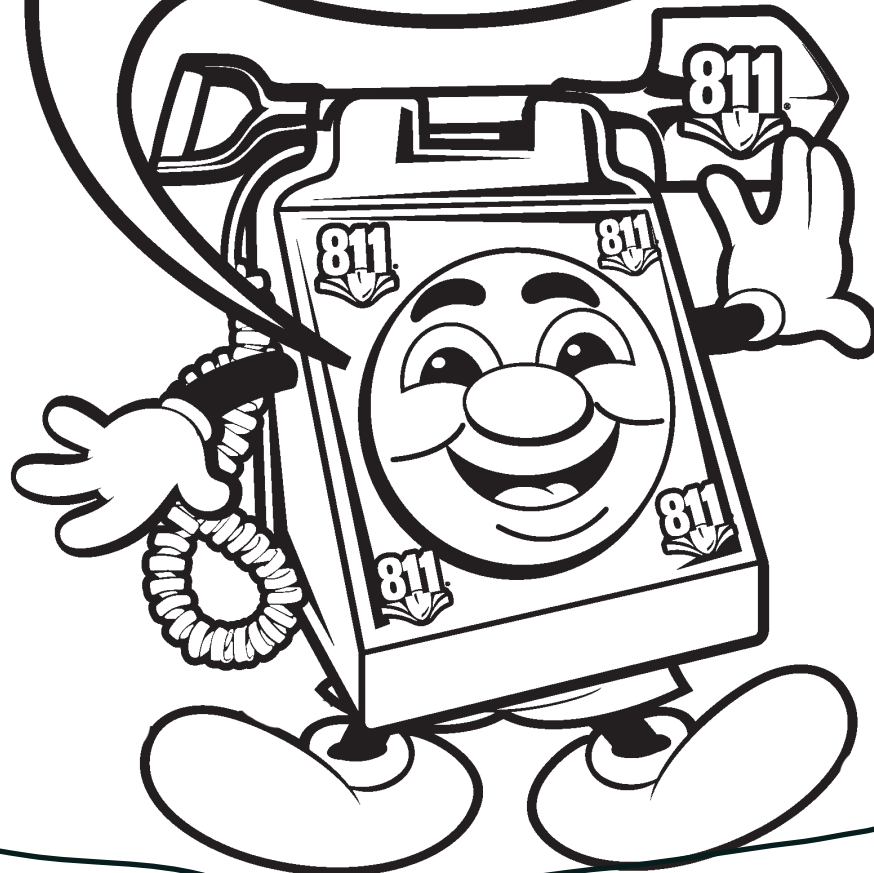

Color-Coded Markers For Underground Utilities

WHITE Proposed Excavation

PINK Temporary Survey Markings

RED Electric Power Lines, Cables or Conduit

YELLOW Gas, Oil, Steam, Petroleum
or Gaseous Materials

ORANGE Communication, Alarm or Signal
Lines, Cables or Conduit

BLUE Potable (Drinkable) Water

PURPLE Reclaimed Water or
Irrigation Lines

GREEN Sewers and Drain Lines

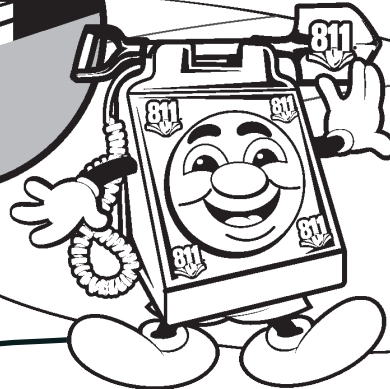
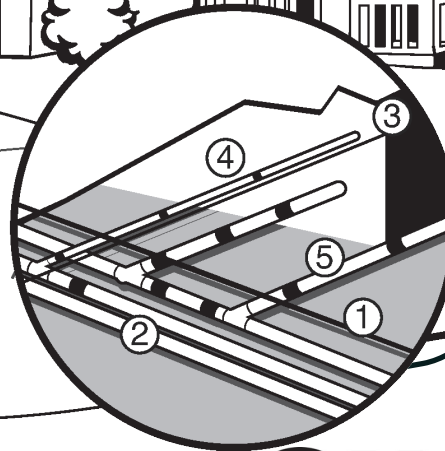

Urban Underground Utility Examples

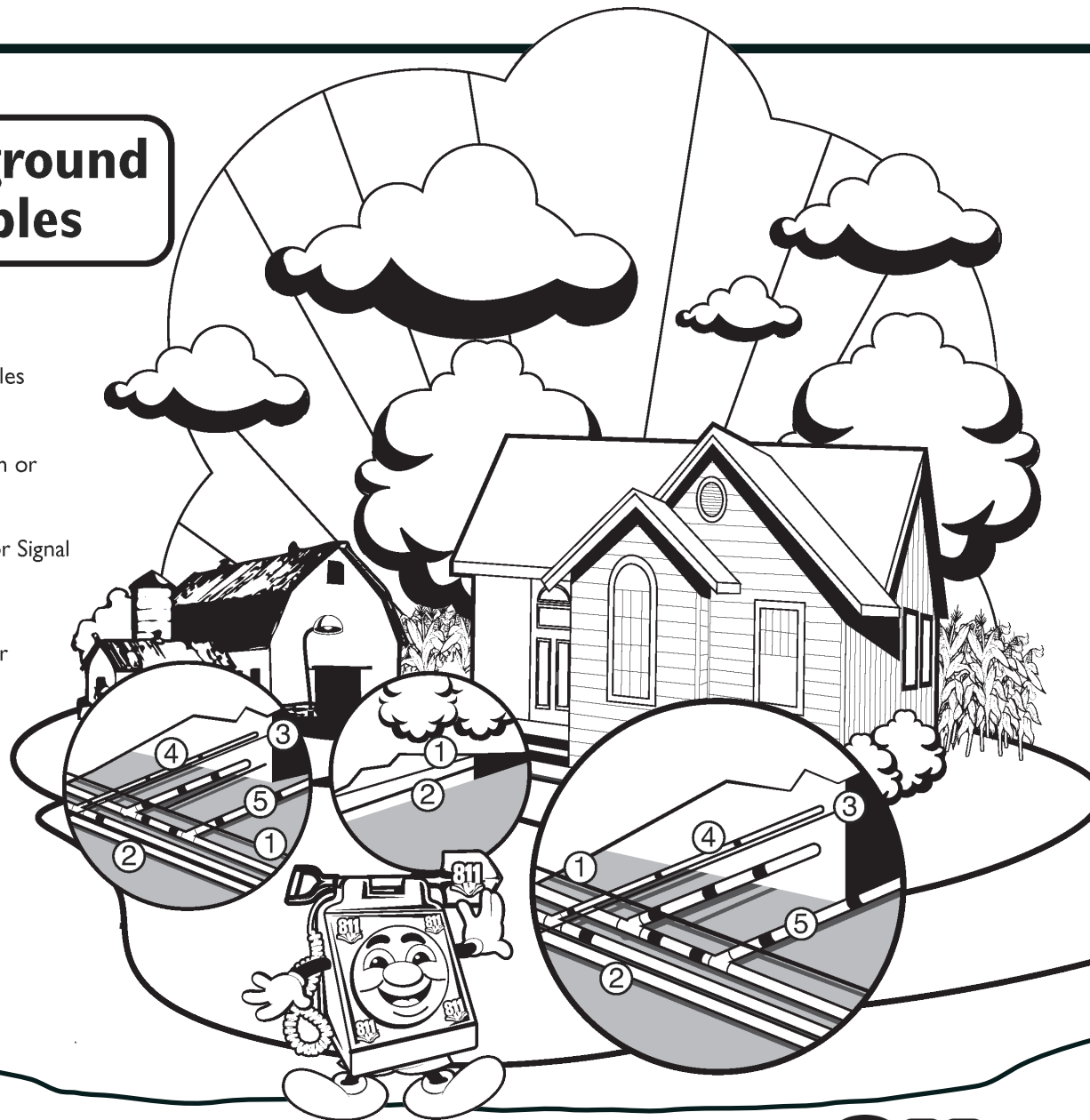
